OUT OF COUNTRY BOARDERS

Parents residing outside of South Africa will be required to pay an additional deposit of one term's fees when your daughter joins The Wykeham Collegiate. The deposit is adjusted annually to match the current year's termly fee.

This is a refundable deposit on completion of your daughter's Grade 12 year.

PAYMENT

Parents who choose to pay the full fee before 15 January will receive a 3.0% early settlement discount on the tuition and boarding fee.

All Monthly and Termly payments must be via Debit Order. Monthly accounts must be paid over 10 months (January – October). All termly accounts are to be paid before the first day of each term.

Should your debit order be returned unpaid, it will attract an R200 admin fee.

Interest will be charged at 1.5% on overdue accounts.

Should you make payment via cash, the cash deposit fee will be added to your account.
